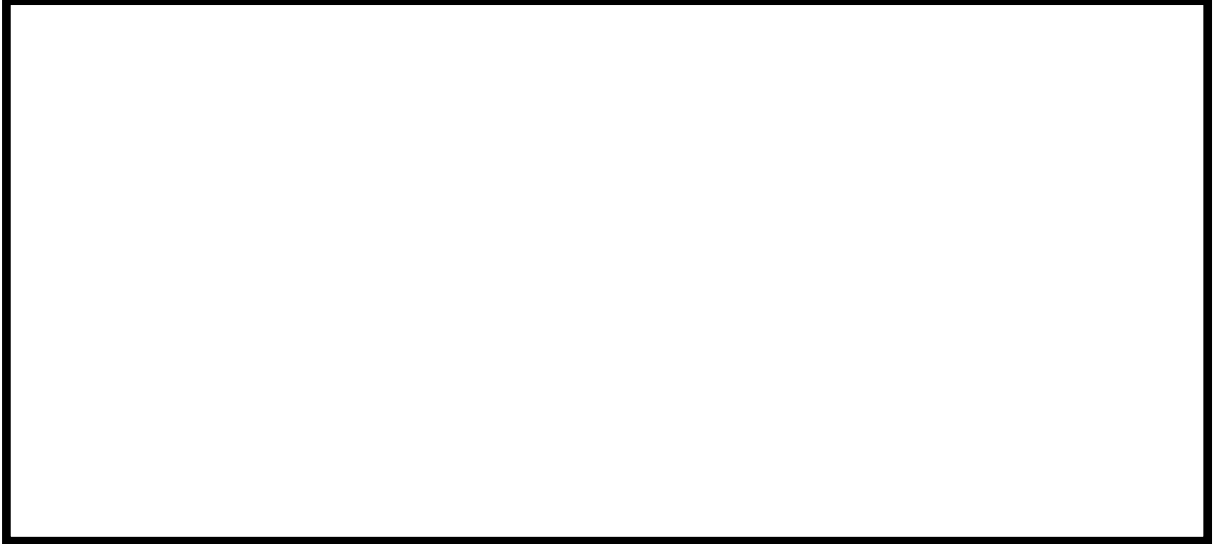


Animal Walk

Animal name: Grey squirrel



How do I move? I can run really fast along the ground and up trees. I can also jump from one branch to another.

What do I eat? Hazel nuts, acorns and berries and occasionally bird eggs and insects. I will also feed on seeds and bread that are put out for birds.

How do I find my food? I mainly forage on the forest floor.

What do my legs and feet look like and how do they help me move and feed? I can use my back legs for jumping, and I can cling to the tree with my claws. I can hold nuts and dig with my front paws.

What does my tail look like? it is big and bushy

What is my tail used for? It helps me balance when I am climbing and jumping.

Listen. What noises do I make? I can make loud calls to communicate with other squirrels that sound like short low grunts. You may also hear me running up trees or chewing on nuts.

Animal name: horse



How do I move? I walk, but I can also trot, canter and gallop. I can move really fast and jump.

What do my legs and feet look like and how do they help me move and feed?

My legs are long and all the same length. I have hooves which give me protection. Four legs help me move fast. I have to bend down to feed, my legs don't help me.

What do I eat? I am a herbivore and I mainly eat grass. Oats or vegetables that are given to me. My teeth can crop grass really short and they are flat for chewing.

How do I find my food? I graze all day, feeding on grass.

What does my tail look like? I have a long tail.

What is my tail used for? To swat flies

Listen. What noises do I make? I neigh to communicate. You can also hear me pull up grass and chew. You may occasionally hear me fart!

Animal name: Rabbit



How do I move? I hop. I can move really fast.

What do I eat? I will eat anything green and most plants and flowers. I particularly like vegetable patches.

How do I find my food? I graze all day on grass. I will search for fresh plants and grass to eat.

What do my legs and feet look like and how do they help me move and feed? My back legs allow me to hop, I have very big back feet. I can use my front paws to help me feed and to dig.

What does my tail look like? I have a small fluffy tail.

What is my tail used for? It may be used as a warning signal. When rabbits run their tail goes up revealing a white patch which can be seen by others.

Listen. What noises do I make? I am very quiet because I don't want to alert predators. I may thump my back feet to alert others of danger.

Animal name: sheep

How do I move? I walk and I can run

What do I eat? Grass and leaves

How do I find my food? I graze all day, I look for green vegetation and leaves.

What do my legs and feet look like and how do they help me move and feed?

My legs are the same length and quite thin. I have hooves which protect me from stones and hard ground, but they are not as hard as horse's hooves. My feet don't help me feed but they can paw at the ground.

What does my tail look like? It can be short or long (depending on if it has been cut)

What is my tail used for? It can be used to flick insects out of the way.

Listen. What noises do I make? I bahhhh, or bleat if I am young.
